New Ad: Kirsten Engel Drops Second Ad of the General Election

Engel hits opponent on border and immigration

TUCSON, AZ — Democratic Candidate for Arizona’s 6th Congressional District, Kirsten Engel, has [released](#) her campaign’s second ad of the cycle. The spot highlights Engel’s strong record in the Arizona Legislature protecting our border, and hits Ciscomani on his



opposition of the bipartisan border security deal negotiated by the senate earlier this year.

“Ciscomani talks a big game on the border but his record is clear, and Arizonans will not be fooled by his photo ops and political posturing,” **said Kirsten Engel.** “Instead of supporting the bipartisan bill that would have increased border security and slowed the flow of fentanyl, Ciscomani opposed it so Donald Trump and Republicans could



continue to campaign on the border. Arizona voters are sick and tired of politicians like Juan Ciscomani putting politics over solutions, and they're going to make that clear this November."

The bipartisan border deal Ciscomani opposed was endorsed by the Border Patrol Union and [included](#) funding for:

- Hiring more Customs and Border Protection agents
- Installing cutting edge drug detection machines at our ports of entry to stop the flow of fentanyl into Arizona
- Additional immigration judges and thousands more Asylum Officers

This is Engel's second ad of the general election campaign and is one of a series of ads we can expect from the campaign this cycle. The campaign has reserved over \$3.5 million in broadcast and digital communications between now and Election Day.

Engel faces Ciscomani in a rematch from 2022, where she lost by approximately 5,000 votes despite being outspent 6 to 1. She is committed to putting Arizona families over Washington special interests – that's why she has rejected corporate PAC contributions to her campaign, and is proud to have received more than 31,000 individual donations this campaign cycle. She has also secured key endorsements locally and nationally, including from Senator Mark Kelly, End Citizens United, Planned Parenthood, and AFSCME.
