Engel to Ciscomani: "I don't trust you with my health care and I don't trust you with my daughter's health care."

TUCSON, AZ — Today, **Democratic Candidate for Arizona's 6th Congressional District, Kirsten Engel**, released her campaign's [twelfth ad](#) of the cycle, titled "Trust." The ad begins with her powerful attack on anti-choice extremist Juan Ciscomani during their most recent debate, in which she tells him: *"I don't trust you with my health care and I don't trust you with my daughter's health care."* The ad focuses on Engel's trust in women and their doctors to make these health care decisions themselves, not politicians.

"I trust women and their doctors to make their own decisions about their reproductive health care," **said Engel**. "Meanwhile, my opponent thinks politicians should have the final say. His extremist anti-choice record shows just how far out of touch Ciscomani is

with Arizona voters. In Congress, I'll fight to defend and expand reproductive freedom and to ensure all women can access the care they need.”

Juan Ciscomani's Anti-Abortion Record:

- As part of the Doug Ducey Administration, Ciscomani [vetted and helped pack the State Supreme Court](#) with the judges who voted in favor of the archaic 1864 abortion ban.
- Immediately upon getting to Washington, he joined the Republican Study Committee which is working to pass the [Life At Conception Act](#), a national abortion ban with no exception for rape, incest, or the life of the mother.
- As part of the House Appropriations Committee, Ciscomani voted in Congress for a clean stand alone amendment to [restrict access to medication abortion nationwide](#).
- Ciscomani also voted to [restrict reproductive care for active duty service members](#).

The campaign has reserved nearly \$5 million in broadcast and digital communications between now and Election Day, and is running Spanish-language communications on broadcast, digital, and radio.

Engel faces Ciscomani in a rematch from 2022, where she lost by approximately 5,000 votes despite being outspent 6 to 1. She is committed to putting Arizona families over Washington special interests – that's why she has rejected corporate PAC money, and is proud to have received more than 78,000 individual donations this campaign cycle. Her average contribution is \$76. She has also secured key endorsements locally and nationally, including from Senator Mark Kelly, End Citizens United, Planned Parenthood, and AFSCME.
