Engel Campaign Demonstrates Strength in First 30 Days

Rematch with Ciscomani draws national attention early

Former State Senator Kirsten Engel lost one of the closest elections in the country last year in a district many ignored. In the month since Engel launched her 2024 campaign, her campaign has already demonstrated she is in an excellent position to win this extraordinarily competitive seat:

- \$100,000 raised in the first 72 hours of launch, demonstrating renewed enthusiasm and broad support from Arizonans.
- The League of Conservation Voters and Advancing Arizona began running ads criticizing Ciscomani for his votes to cut veterans benefits, border security, and more. Last year, Engel's campaign was outspent 6:1, mostly by Kevin McCarthy and GOP dark money groups. Early buy-in from organizations critical of Ciscomani demonstrates a shift in how AZ-06 is perceived nationally.
- Moms Fed Up, the PAC started by former Congresswoman Ann Kirkpatrick announced yesterday their support for Engel. They join a growing and diverse list of endorsers including Congressman Ruben Gallego, Sheriff Chris Nanos, former Congresswoman Ann Kirkpatrick, and former Congressman Ron Barber.

"In a district that had been redrawn to favor a Republican candidate, in a midterm year where Democratic turnout was low, and with virtually no buy-in from outside groups, Kirsten Engel came very close to winning this seat," campaign spokesman Wes Share said. "In 30 days Kirsten has already demonstrated that she has what it takes to finish the job and take back this seat."
