Kirsten Engel Reacts to Trump's Comments on Monitoring Women's Pregnancies

Engel calls on Ciscomani to rescind his endorsement of the former president

TUCSON, AZ — Today, Kirsten Engel released the following statement condemning former President Trump's chilling comments allowing state governments to monitor women's pregnancies to ensure they have not had an abortion.

"These comments from the former President are truly horrifying" **stated Engel**. "I am appalled at the direction the GOP is taking our country. The government has no place in making these decisions, and to even suggest that the government should monitor women's pregnancies is a gross invasion of privacy. If elected, I vow to fight back against this in Congress. To my opponent, I ask, can you in good conscience support these Orwellian violations of women's privacy? Can you really continue to endorse the former President as he calls for the government to monitor a woman's pregnancy?"

Engel's campaign has raised over \$500k since the Supreme Court decision was announced earlier this month. This is approximately four times the amount her campaign raised at this juncture in 2022, showing there is real opposition in southern Arizona on restricting women's ability to make their own healthcare decisions.

A long time advocate for abortion rights, Engel is proud to have the endorsements of top national organizations, which work tirelessly to protect this fundamental right, such as Planned Parenthood, EMILY's List, and Reproductive Freedom for All.
